## Agenda discussed and resolutions taken:

- Confirmation of the previous IQAC meeting held on 14<sup>th</sup> July 2020 Resolution: Resolved that the proceedings of the previous IQAC meeting be confirmed.
- Reopening of College post-lockdown (under the direction of the Directorate of Univ. & Higher education, Govt. of Manipur)

Resolution: As per notification from the Directorate of Univ. & Higher Education vide letter no. 3/219/98-EDC, dated 3<sup>rd</sup> Sept 2020, it was resolved that the college will reopen from 9<sup>th</sup> September 2020 in preparation for the upcoming 6<sup>th</sup> semester examinations. As the college was utilised as a Quarantine centre with few inmates testing positive for the corona virus, it was resolved that a one-day NSS social service and an extensive sanitisation programme be organised on the 8<sup>th</sup> of Sept 2020. All teaching and non-teaching faculty members who are not from containment areas are to participate in the said post-lockdown campus sanitisation programme.

Further, it is decided that the college would remain open from 9<sup>th</sup> to 15<sup>th</sup> Sept 2020 for students who may wish to attend college for class or any queries. Teachers who teach the 6<sup>th</sup> semester classes must attend college during these said days compulsorily whilst maintaining SOP. Those teachers who are in containment zones are exempted from attending college.

It is also resolved that the college bus will ply through select main routes for staff members and students who may wish to avail the bus services since public transportation is not yet available currently.

- 3. Final Examination of BA/BSC/BCom/BFT/BBT6<sup>th</sup> Semester
  - Resolution: Discussed about the upcoming end semester exams for the 6<sup>th</sup> semester which will commence from 18<sup>th</sup> Sept 2020 onwards. Resolved that the Examination committee form a coordinating committee to ensure smooth conduct of exams while maintaining SOP.
- 4. Internal Examination for 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Semesters
  - Resolution: As the end semester University exams for the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> semesters are scrapped due to the covid pandemic, it is resolved that students would be promoted based on the internal assessment marks. Respective departments will conduct internal exams virtually for 50 marks each for each theory paper and the marks obtained are to be submitted to the Principal through the Examination committee.
- 5. Online admission for the Academic session 2020-21
  - Resolution: Discussed about the admission process which has been converted to online mode starting from the next session 2020-21 onwards. Resolved that all admissions will be through online registration and as per Admission notice issued by the Directorate of University and Higher education, dated 31<sup>st</sup> August 2020, the last date for online registration for admissions to undergraduate (UG) Programmes for the academic session 2020-21 has been extended till midnight of 17<sup>th</sup> September 2020.

6. Participation in NIRF

Resolution: Discussed and resolved that the college participate in NIRF as a Quality Assurance initiative. Dr. Wahengbam Robindro Singh, RUSA Nodal Officer/HOD, Department of Biotechnology is entrusted to do the needful.

- Activities to be conducted Resolution: Resolved to organise the following activities:
