1. Confirmation of the previous IQAC meeting held on 18th April 2019
Resolution: Resolved that the proceedings of the previous IQAC meeting be confirmed.
2. Review of activities undertaken in last academic session
Resolution: A brief report of the activities undertaken by the IQAC in the was presented by the Coordinator. It was regretted that the SSR report couldn't be prepared on time; members pledged to make efforts to make sure to do the needful for the 2nd cycle of NAAC assessment during the current session.
3. Freeship for students for the academic session 2019-20
Resolution: As discussed in the previous IQAC meeting,
 - i. Free ship will be provided to the position holders upto 20 Positions at the Higher Secondary Examinations.

- ii. Free ship will be provided to the Sport Persons who bagged 1st to 3rd Positions or medals at the National or International Level.
- iii. Free ship will be provided to the disabled persons who have more than 70% and above.
- iv. Tuition Fee will be exempted to the students who have scored 80% and above.
- v. Half Tuition Fee will be provided to the students who have scored 70% and above but below 80%.

4. Workshops/Seminars/other activities:

- 5. Resolution: A 6-Day workshop on Plant Molecular Taxonomy is to be organised from 15th-20th July 2019 by DBT- Advanced Level Institutional Biotech Hub of the college.

- 6. Discussion on Stride-a new Scheme to promote quality research by Students and teachers of HEI.
