Nuja Charei Jagoi', which literally means the (women) 'Dance of Handloom fabrics', is one of a kind initiatives and fashion show event conducted as an integral part of the passing out of BVoc Fashion Technology final year students of S. Kula Women's College.

As with the title adopted for the show, all the customs are designed solely from Manipur's handlooms textiles, which is the backbone of the entire fabrics and silhouette thus use during the

show. And this was to highlight the values of Manipur's handloom textile and to increase its marketability beyond, from the predominant traditional and cultural wears. And the event itself provides a glimpse of making the handlooms fabrics a global trend with designers skills and possibilities of great Monetization in future as contemporary wear.
