**Subject : Organising training on "WATER QUALITY ISSUES AND GROUND WATER STRESS AREAS" under aegis of NGWT&RI at S. Kula Women's College, Nambol, Bishnupur.**

Sir,

This is to inform that National Ground Water Training & Research Institute (Raipur), a training wing of Central Ground Water Board, Ministry of Water Resources, River Development & Ganga Rejuvenation, Govt. of India is envisaged to function as a 'Centre of Excellence' in training groundwater resources personnel. It has a national role of conducting training courses for all groundwater sector personnel, in the specialised and emerging areas. State or other institutes are not adequately equipped to meet the training needs in the ground water sector.

Ground water resource is in public domain and increasingly being exploited on large scale that has led to sharp decline in groundwater level and deterioration of water quality in major parts of the India. Realizing the need to provide trainings to groundwater professionals, sub-professional and other stake holders the Institute has embarked upon a three tier training program. The objective of these trainings is to develop a pool of trained resource persons who would be working towards sustainability of ground water resource. In Tier- I Training, the trainings are provided in core groundwater areas with scientific input to state and central level ground water professionals and sub-professionals in the Institute at Raipur. As a large pool of trained human resource are needed to work on sustainability which cannot be trained in short duration at Raipur, the Institute has been organizing state level trainings to groundwater professionals and sub-professionals under its Tier II Training program. It has been envisaged to carry out Ground Water Management through a Participatory approach. In order to train grass-root level stake holders in basic skills of ground water data collection and assistance in field studies Tier- III Block Level trainings are being organized by the Institute through CGWB Regional and State Unit Offices.

As a part of the three tiered training programme being implemented by NGWTRI, CGWB under HRD and capacity Building Plan Scheme, 53 number of Block Level trainings are to be organised in the calendar year 2017-18. One training programmes of Tier - III has been sanctioned for organizing in Manipur as per the approved training calendar of NGWTRI for 2017-18.

The Tier III training programme is a village / block levels training - cum - awareness programme under the capacity building programme of NGWTRI, Central Ground Water Board, Ministry of
