#### INTRODUCTION

Feedback is an essential part of our continuous endeavour to overcome challenges and achieve excellence in the teaching and learning process, and to identify areas for further development. This report focuses on the feedback received from students, teachers and alumnae.


#### STUDENT'S FEEDBACK:

The Students' Feedback of S. Kula Women's College is designed to access student's perception of the curriculum in terms of design and delivery, teachers' commitment and efforts, and students' overall learning experience. Only 38 student feedback forms were received by the Feedback Cell for the academic year 2019-20 by the end of the academic session. Majority of the students agreed that the course curriculum is relevant to real life situations. Likewise, majority of the students also agreed that their curriculum contains high learning values.


#### INTERPRETATION:

- Analysis of the report suggests that students are satisfied with their course curriculum design and delivery. However, some also expressed the need for periodical revision of the syllabi of courses they are enrolled in especially the mainstream subjects.
- Students are satisfied with the teaching methods employed by their teachers and the conduct of internal assessments.
- Students expressed the need for more opportunities for student exchange/internship/field visits etc in their curriculum.
- Also, even though many of them agreed on the availability of adequate laboratory facilities, there is still room for much improvement.
- Students are satisfied with the overall academic ambience of the college.






#### **TEACHERS' FEEDBACK**

Feedback is sought from the teachers on aspects related to curriculum and the teaching-learning process. 57 teachers responded to the feedback process to which they expressed their honest views on curriculum design, revision/update of course contents, library resources and infrastructural facilities for teaching, teacher training, conduct of exams etc.


#### INFERENCE:

- Majority (84%) of the teachers agreed that the curriculum design of their respective
  courses are in line with the current scenario. Nevertheless, teachers also expressed that the
  curriculum needs to be updated periodically. Teachers do not have much freedom to
  revise/modify the syllabi of their courses as the college follows the curriculum only
  approved by the affiliating University, Manipur University.
- Majority of the teachers are also satisfied with the library resources and other infrastructure facilities available in the college. However, they also opined the need for routine and regular maintenance for improving efficiency.
- Teacher also provided several valuable suggestions for improving the college and these have noted for necessary action.












6. Are you satisfied with the available infrastructure facility?



7. Are you satisfied with the student/teacher relationship?








#### **ALUMNAE FEEDBACK**

#### INFERENCE:


- It is observed that majority of the alumnae members gave positive response to course coverage.

- Majority (70%) of them are satisfied with the overall environment of the college.


### 1. Coverage of course syllabus by teachers as prescribed by University









