About the college

S. Kula Women's College was established in the year, 1981 exclusively for girls with an initial objective to disseminate knowledge of higher education to the women especially in the rural areas of Nambol under Bishnupur District of the State of Manipur. S. Kula Women's College has since progressed to become one of the top performing colleges in Manipur. The college is a multi-faculty college offering several undergraduate programmes in Arts, Science, Commerce including Applied Sciences and Vocational Courses.

The college is affiliated to the Manipur University and recognized by the UGC under Section 2(f) and 12(b) of the UGC Act. The college is conferred "Colleges with Potential for Excellence" by the UGC in 2006, and subsequently the college could achieve NAAC Grade "A" in 2012, as a first of its kind in Manipur.
