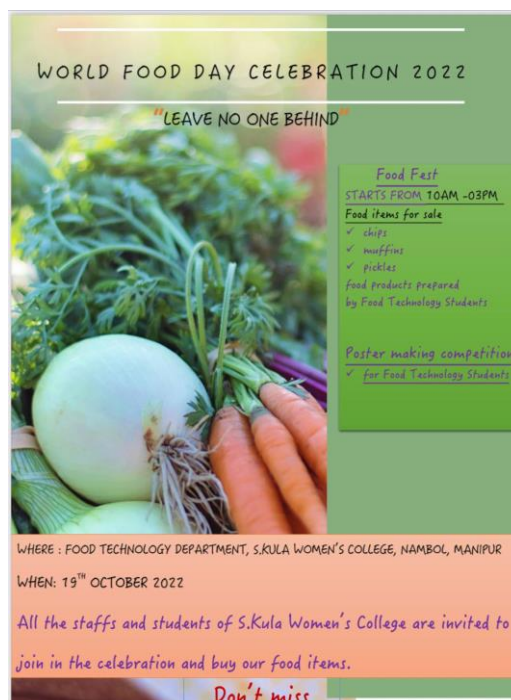
Theme: “Leave No One Behind”

a) Poster Making Competition

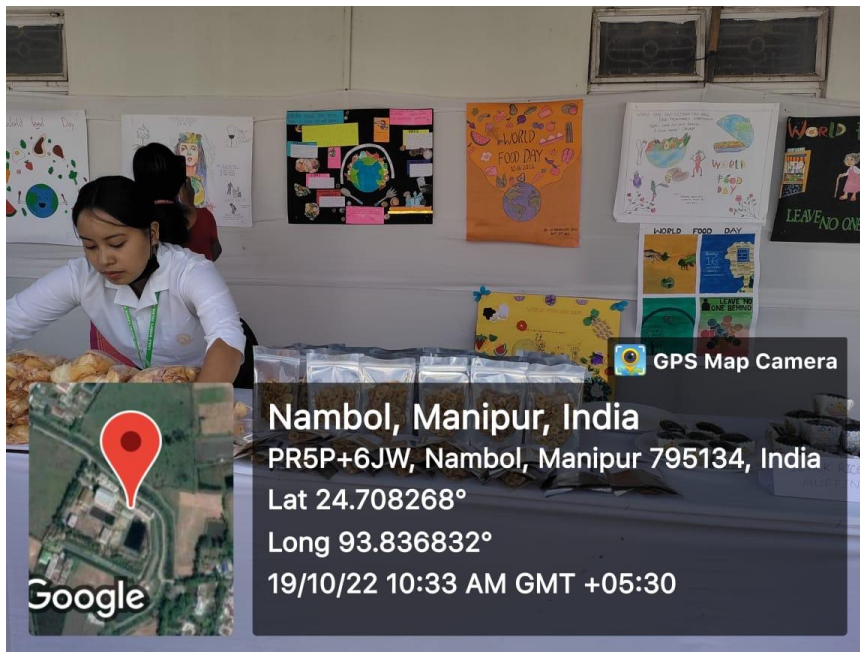
