Further, a **Compliance / Action Taken Report (ATR)** on the observance shall be submitted on the same day by **3:00 p.m.**, or at the earliest thereafter, for record and reference.

This may be treated as **most urgent**.

Subject:- Observance of silence on 30th January (Martyrs' Day) in the memory of those who sacrificed their lives during struggle for India's freedom-

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to say that on 30th January, every year, two minutes' silence is observed at 11.00 AM., throughout the country, in the memory of those who sacrificed their lives during the struggle for India's freedom.

2. The following standing instructions have been laid down for observance of this day:

- (i) Silence should be observed and work and movement stopped for two minutes throughout the country at 11.00 A.M. on 30th January.
- (ii) Wherever feasible, the commencement and termination of the two minutes' silence period should be indicated by sound of siren or Army guns. Sirens should be sounded from 10.59 hours till 11.00 hours and after two minutes, all clear sirens should again be sounded from 11.02 hours till 11.03 hours. This procedure may be adopted where sirens exist.
- (iii) On hearing the signal (wherever available), all persons would stand up and observe the silence.
- (iv) At places where no signal systems is available, suitable instructions can be issued to all concerned for observing the silence for two minutes at 11.00 A.M.

3. In the past, it has been observed that while two minutes' silence is observed in some offices, the general public goes about its occupation in the ordinary course, unmindful of the solemnity of the occasion. The States/Union Territories Governments are requested to ensure that the Martyrs' Day is observed with due solemnity. States/Union Territories Government may issue instructions to all educational institutions and Public Sector Enterprises under their control for observance of the Martyrs' Day, accordingly. Talks/speeches on freedom struggle and national integration may also be organised including in hybrid mode.



Imphal, the 27th January, 2026

The Martyrs' Day is being observed on the 30th January, 2026 from 10.10 am to 11.04 a.m. in commemoration of the death anniversary of Mahatama Gandhi, the Father of the Nation. The following 3 (three Bhajans shall be the sung from 10.10 am. to 10.51 am.

- I. SUMIRAN KARLE MERE MANA
 - II. VAISHNAV JANA TO TENE and
 - III. RAGHUPATI RAGHAV RAJA RAM.
2. A siren will be sounded from 10.59 a.m. till 11.00 a.m. as warning signal for observance of two minutes' silence. Another siren will be sounded from 11.02 a.m. to 11.03 a.m. as closing signal. During the two minutes' silence, vehicles along the highway and campus areas will come to a standstill.
3. All citizens are requested to observed 2 minutes silence when the signal as aforesaid is sounded. They are also expected to stand wherever they are for observing the same.
4. The function is being observed at the Gandhi Memorial Hall, Imphal. The Hon'ble Governor of Manipur will be the Chief Guest and the Chief Secretary, Govt of Manipur as the President respectively. Other dignitaries of the State Government are also attending the function.
5. All Government servants working within the Imphal Municipal area including Lamphelpat are requested to be present at GM. Hall on 30.1.2026 at 10.00 a.m. till the function is over.
